The main body of the windsurfing sail is made of varying weights of Dacron, laminates, monofilm and tapes. Sometimes *exact* replacement materials are no longer available or not cost effective / almost impossible to obtain. Where *exact* replacement of materials is not a viable option I will replace with similar materials of the correct performance specification. I have a large and broad range of materials in stock.

I will let you know if I think your sail is beyond economic repair. This could be due to factors such as over-exposure to UV causing the materials to become brittle and weak, excessive wear or severe damage. I can advise you on options for replacing the sail.
